


Sharon Cooper, MD is a developmental and forensic pediatrician. She is an Adjunct Professor of Pediatrics at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill School of Medicine. She is a Board member of the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. She provides patient care, investigative assistance and expert witness testimony in cases of child abuse and sexual exploitation.

Dr. Cooper has provided more than a hundred training seminars around the world. She is also the lead author of the most comprehensive text on child sexual exploitation and internet crimes against children, entitled "Child Sexual Exploitation."

Detective Cathy De La Paz, a 23 year veteran of the Dallas Police Department, is the lead detective assigned to the High Risk Victims and Trafficking Unit, within the Child Exploitation Squad. She specializes in conducting interviews of adolescent children and non-compliant victims who may be deceptive, avoidant and/or tentative in their disclosures.

Detective De La Paz has instructed for the Dallas Police Department Academy, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children, The FBI, The Department of Justice, and many other agencies and conferences throughout the country.
