The State of Alaska, Department of Corrections, is recruiting for the position of Director of Institutions.

Among other duties, this position is responsible for the daily security and operations of the 12 statewide correctional institutions which provide care and custody of incarcerated persons housed within the department. This position is responsible for oversight of all operations and policy implementation within the various institutions as well as institutional planning to ensure that institutional goals and objectives are consistent and compatible with goals and objectives set by the department and administration.

Demonstrated leadership skills are an essential component of this job. The Director oversees 12 facilities, a staff of 1,400 and various contractors. The annual starting salary is \$102,972 but may vary depending on qualifications.

The Division Director of Institutions will be placed into the PERS retirement plan and will accrue service under "all others" also known as "A" service. When the Division Director chooses to retire; the service will be eligible for conversion to "P" service as long as the Division Director meets the **five year employment requirement of one of the following: probation officer, correctional officer, assistant correctional superintendent, or correctional superintendent at a state correctional facility.**
