

Comprehensive Classification Operations Management



National Recognized Decision Tree Model


The classification instruments are fully automated with appropriate information displayed to answer each risk split. The classification officer can seamlessly add criminal history, disciplinary history alert flags and holds/detainers while conducting the classification. The reclassification instruments work the same way. After the classification is completed the officer is given the opportunity to override the classification with a required reason and the next review date is automatically set.




Classification Summary Screen

Comprehensive Housing Management COMPAS

Classification provides for comprehensive inmate cell management, if desired, utilizing an interface with your JMS. Through custom cell configuration, COMPAS Classification will select a list of all available housing matching the inmate's classification level, all special needs beds or all available beds in the system. The system warns the officer if an inmate is being placed in a cell with known enemies, codefendants or the cell's designation does not match the classification level. The system displays who is currently in that cell and keeps a housing history permanently in the system for each incarceration.

Dashboards, Quick Charts and Ad-hoc Reporting

User configured dashboards, our "Quick Charts" feature and the Ad-hoc Report Generator provide numerous rosters, statistical data and "to do" lists to both classification staff and administrators.
